We use the Present Simple to talk about facts, routines and habits.

+ I / You often **run**.  
He / She / It **runs**.  
We / You / They **run**.

- I / You don't often **run**.  
He / She / It **doesn't run**.  
We / You / They **don't run**.

? **Do** I / you **run every day**?  
**Does** he / she / it **run**?  
**Do** we / you / they **run**?  
Where **do** you **run**?  
When **does** he **run**?

Short answers	Adverbs of frequency
Yes, he <b>does</b> . / No, he <b>doesn't</b> .	always • usually • often
Yes, we <b>do</b> . / No, we <b>don't</b> .	sometimes • rarely • never
