




THE IMMUNE SYSTEM

Hello guys!

Today we are going to talk about the Immune system. But first, you have to look a video.



According to the video, this system is a network of cells, tissues and organs that defend the body against harmful toxins and microorganisms.

The immune system protects your body from outside invaders. These include germs such as bacteria, viruses, and fungi, and toxins (chemicals made by microbes).

There are 2 main parts of the immune system:

- **The innate immune system.** You are born with this.
- **The adaptive immune system.** You develop this when your body is exposed to microbes or chemicals released by microbes.
