

Practicing Pronouns and Vocabulary in Daniel's Story by Carol Matas (chapters 2 - 4)

Remember that **an antecedent** for a pronoun is the noun it is taking the place of in the sentence.

For example: The girl told the **baby doll** to behave herself.

Herself is a **reflexive pronoun** and the antecedent is **baby doll**.
