8. Interaction with the audience	10 points		Did the speaker engage the audience with questions, comments, or examples?
9. Creativity and impact	10 points		Was the speech interesting or creative? Did it leave a lasting impression?
10. Coherence and cohesion	10 points		Were the ideas well connected and was the speech coherent in its development?
