A. GRAMMAR

I. Past simple tenses (Thì Quá khứ đơn)

– **Cách dùng:** Thì quá khứ đơn dùng để nói về hành động đã xảy ra và kết thúc trong quá khứ.

– **Cấu trúc:**

	TO BE	ĐỘNG TỪ THƯỜNG
Khẳng định	S + was/ were + Adj/N.	S + V-ed/2 + O.
Phủ định	S + was/ were + not + Adj/N.	S + did not + V-inf + O.
Nghi vấn	Was/ Were + S + Adj/N? → Yes, S + was/ were . → No, S + was/ were + not .	Did + S + V-inf + O? → Yes, S + did . → No, S + did + not .

– **Dấu hiệu nhận biết:** *yesterday* (hôm qua), *last week/ month/ year* (tuần/ tháng/ năm trước), ... *ago* (cách đây ...), *in 1999* (vào năm 1999)

Note: Adj = Adjective: Tính từ, N = Noun: Danh từ, V-inf = Infinitive: Động từ nguyên mẫu, V-ed/2: Động từ thêm "ed" ở dạng quá khứ/ động từ bất quy tắc, O = Objective: Tân ngữ.

- Những động từ có quy tắc (regular verbs): chúng ta chỉ cần thêm **-ed** vào sau động từ.

Ex: live – lived, start – started, watch – watched, ...

- Chúng ta **không thêm -ed** vào những động từ bất quy tắc (irregular verbs), mà chúng ta phải học thuộc lòng chúng.

Ex: be – was/were, do – did, go – went, ...
