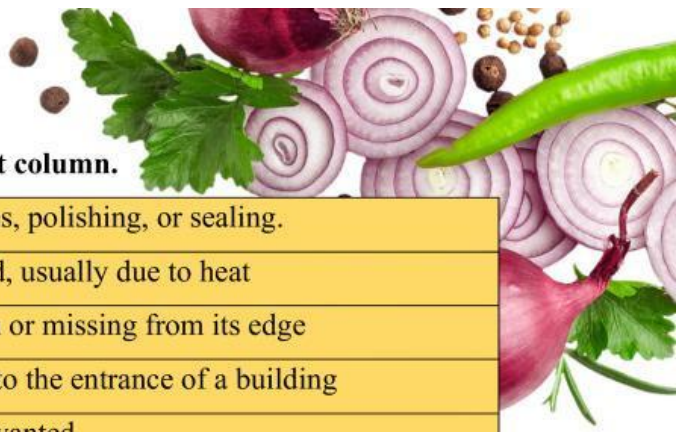




Ex.1. Match the words with their definition in the right column.
