THE INCREDIBLE SHRINKING OF A CHOCOLATE BAR

Do you love chocolate?

If you do, then you know that chocolate bars aren't as big as they used to be.

In 2013 the average chocolate bar weighed fifty-five grams, in 2016 it was only forty-nine grams.
