Tawhid ar-Rubūbiyyah (Oneness of Lordship) "توحيد الربوبية"

Tawhid al-Ulūhiyyah (Oneness of Worship) "توحيد الألوهية"

Tawhid al-Asmā' wa as-Sifāt (Oneness of the Names and the Attributes) "توحيد الأسماء والصفات"

It means to believe in Allah's names and attributes that are mentioned in the Qur'an and Sunnah without Tamthil (drawing resemblance between Allah and His creatures), Tashbih (likening).

It means to believe that Allah alone is the Creator, the Provider, the Owner, and the Disposer of Affairs.

It means to single Allah out with worship, i.e., to worship none but Allah Almighty.
