What is the Thai Elephant Home?

Our home is a safe place for tired and old elephants.



How can I help?

We want volunteers to help look after our elephants. We cannot pay you but we can give you a free place to sleep and food to eat. You must be 10 years old or above. Under 18s must come with a parent. You can stay for 1 week to 6 weeks.



What do volunteers do every day?

- 6:30 a.m. Get up
- 6:45 a.m. Walk to the forest with the elephants
(The elephants find their breakfast there.)
- 7:15 a.m. Clean the elephants' house
- 8:30 a.m. Have breakfast
- 9:30 a.m. Learn about elephants
- 11:00 a.m. Pick food for the animals
(pineapples, bananas, sweetcorn)
- 1:00 p.m. Have lunch
- 2:00 p.m. Walk to the river with the elephants
(The elephants have a bath there.)
- 4:30 p.m. Feed the elephants
- 5:00 p.m. Finish work
- 6:30 p.m. Have dinner
- 7:30 p.m. Free time
- 10:30 p.m. Go to bed

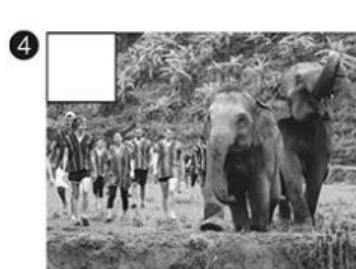
