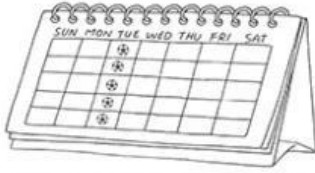

Simple present tense • Present continuous tenseSimon **plays** football on Tuesdays.We use the **simple present tense** to talk about habits.**Simple present tense**I / we / you / they + **verb**
he / she / it + **verb + s / es / y → ies**

Use this tense with:

- **every** day / week
- **on** Mondays

He **is playing** football now.We use the **present continuous tense** to talk about things that are happening now.**Present continuous tense**I **am** + **verb + ing**
he / she / it **is** + **verb + ing**
we / you / they **are** + **verb + ing**

Use this tense with:

- **now**
