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CONVERSATION STARTERS	
	Friendly, gender-neutral term for addressing someone close.
	Asking about someone's current week, typically mid-week.
	General inquiry about recent changes in someone's life.
	Inquiring about the plans or activities for the upcoming week.
	General inquiry about recent changes in someone's life.
DRAMATIC EXPRESSIONS	
	Used to describe something unbelievable or shocking.
	Similar to "mental," used for surprising or extreme situations.
	Can express disbelief or emphasize something funny.
	A dramatic way to express shock or disbelief.
PHRASAL VERBS	
	Casual way to ask someone to wait briefly.
	Refers specifically to cleaning dishes.
	Means to tidy or organize a space.
	To postpone a decision until later, often until the next day.
	To access or exit an online account.
	To direct one's attention to something visually.
	A cautionary phrase to be aware of something.
	To reconnect or update someone on news.
GEN Z PHRASES	
	Often used for emphasis, even if not technically correct.
	Common way to recount dialogue or reactions in a casual manner.
	Used to express thoughts or feelings casually.
	Encouragement to boost someone's confidence.
MISCELLANEOUS	
	Strong affirmation; means definitely or absolutely.
	Indicates moderate confidence about something.
	A way to express amazement or opinion about something.
	Used to preface a personal opinion or revelation.
	A congratulatory phrase for someone's achievement.
