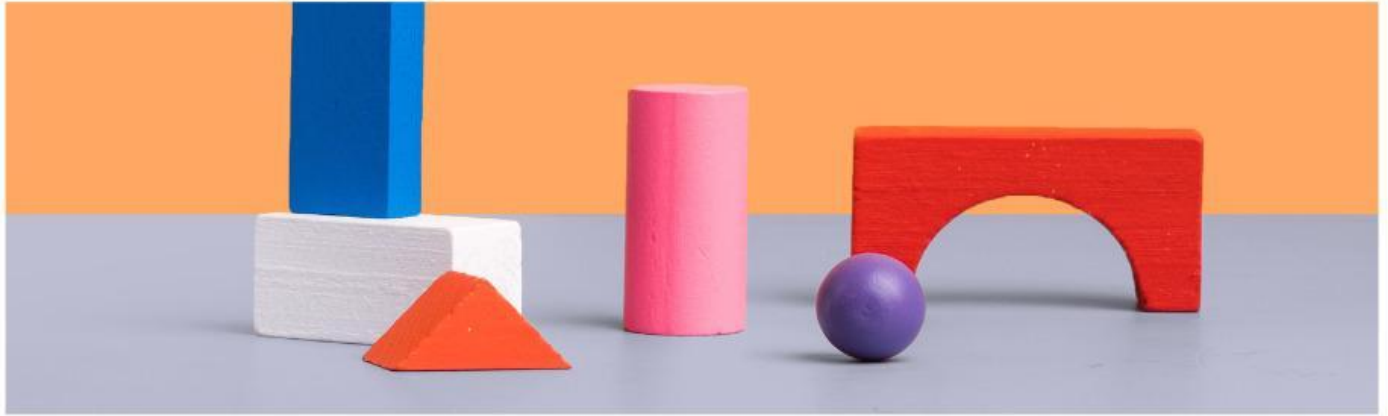




# Determiners:
