- **Go without = decide not to have something or be unable to have something:**

He **went without** water.

- **Go through = suffer or experience:** My grandfather **went through** two wars.
- **Go back = return:** I loved Paris and I want to **go back**.
- **Go on = happen or continue:** I'm so tired, I can't **go on**. / Something strange is **going on** in the centre of town.
- **Go with = match, go well with:** That jacket **goes with** those trousers.
