

# Past continuous: Negative & Interrogative

	STRUCTURE	EXAMPLES
AFFIRMATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	When I saw them they <b>were sitting</b> at a café. Cuando les vi <b>estaban sentados</b> en una cafetería.
NEGATIVE	Sujeto + was / were + not + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)	What did you say? I <b>wasn't listening</b> . (tú) ¿Qué has dicho? <b>No estaba escuchando</b> .
INTERROGATIVE	Was / Were + sujeto + verbo (-ing) + (complemento)?	What <b>were</b> you <b>talking</b> about? (tú) ¿De qué <b>estabais hablando</b> ?
