The "greenhouse effect" is the warming that happens when certain gases in Earth's atmosphere (24) _____ heat. These gases let in light but keep heat from escaping, like the glass walls of a greenhouse. First, sunlight shines onto the Earth's surface, (25) _____ it is absorbed and then radiates back into the atmosphere as heat.
