Phrasal verbs	meaning	Example
1. give up/ give in	เลิก / ยอมแพ้	Please give up smoking.
2. give away	ให้ไป / แจกฟรี	Tim is so rich that he gives away his money.
3. get over	หาย / ดีใจ / ผ่านพ้น	Ken has just gotten over the cancer.
4. get away	หนี / พ้น / หลบหนี	You won't get away with this.
5. get along	ไปด้วยดี / เข้ากันได้	I can get along with my roommates.
6. get through	ผ่านพ้น	Sooner or later, you will get through it.
7. get rid of	กำจัด	I will get rid of this weed for you.
8. get lost	หลงทาง / หลงไป	Guys, stick together. It's easy to get lost in here.
10. think over	ทบทวน	Please think over before doing something.
11. take away	เอาไป / รับประทาน	Do you want to eat in or take away?
12. take turn	ผลัดกัน	A and B take turns playing chess.
13. take side	ลำเอียง	Don't take side. Be neutral.
14. take place	เกิดขึ้น	Our wedding took place in our house.
15. take after	เหมือน / เหมือน	Lisa takes after her mother's smile.
16. look for	หา / ค้นหา	What are you looking for?
17. look after	ดูแล	My parents look after me and my sisters.
18. look up	ค้นพบ	I will look up the meaning of this word.
19. look up to	ยกย่อง / เกรง	Jeremy looks up to his Science teacher.
20. look out/watch out	ดูให้ดี / ระวัง	Watch out! The rocks are falling down.
21. look down	ดูถูก	Don't look down on me. You are not that good.
22. break in/into	บุกรุก	A thief broke into my friend's house last night.
23. break up	เลิก (ความสัมพันธ์)	Lilly broke up with her boyfriend yesterday.
24. call on	โทรหา / ขอร้อง	My mom called on me at my dormitory.
25. call something off	ยกเลิก	I can't go there so I will call the meeting off.
26. cut in/interrupt	แทรก / ขัดจังหวะ	You shouldn't cut in while I am speaking.
27. put off/postpone	เลื่อน	Our party needed to be put off due to Covid-19.
28. put up with	ทน	I can't put up with these problems anymore.
29. put aside	พักไว้ / ขาด	Put aside the dough and prepare for the sauce.
30. put out	ดับไฟ	Fire fighters are putting out the fire.

31. bring about/out	ก่อให้เกิด / cause	Laziness brings about failure.
32. bring someone down	ทำให้ผิดหวัง	I bring my dad down because I lied to him.
33. bring up	เลี้ยงดู	My grandparents bring me up.
34. blow up	ระเบิด	Run away before the bomb blows up.
35. throw up	อาเจียน / vomit	I'm feeling sick and I am going to throw up.
36. fall behind	ด้นถึงด้า	You are falling behind with the rent.
37. count on/rely on	เชื่อถือ / พึ่งพาได้	You can't count on Gina. She is unreliable.
38. come across/ bump into/ run into	บังเอิญเจอ	Helen came across her ex-boyfriend yesterday.
39. pass out	เผลอหลับ / หมดสติ	I can't watch this. I'm going to pass out.
40. pass away	สิ้น ตาย	Our grandmother has just passed away.
41. run out of	หมด / ใช้นหมด	This car runs out of engine.
42. turn up	มาขึ้น / ปรากฏตัว / ใกล้เคียง	We are happy to know that she turns up.
43. turn down	ทาล้าง / ปล่อยให้	Please turn down the light. I can't sleep.
44. turn into	กลายเป็น	Jack turns into an introvert when he grows up
45. drop in/stop by	แวะเยี่ยม	Papa will drop by our house tomorrow.
46. carry on	ทำต่อไป	I carry on writing a report for next week meeting.
47. calm down	ใจเย็น	Calm down and think about the future.
48. catch up	ตามทัน	You speak too fast so I can't catch up.
49. cheer up	ให้กำลังใจ	Don't worry. Friends will cheer you up.
50. lay off	ไล่ออก / ปลดออก	The company will lay off many crew workers
51. point out	ชี้แจง / ทำให้เห็นค่า	Help me point out the importance of the test.
52. fill in	เติม (ข้อมูล)	Please fill in this application form before you go.
53. pass on	ส่งต่อ	I will pass on the dessert and have some drinks
54. live up to	ประสบความสำเร็จ	She never lived up to her expectations.
55. pull over	จอดข้างทาง	Don't pull over here. It's too dark.
56. try out	ทดสอบใช้	Let's try out a new software.
57. wipe out	กวาดล้าง / หมดไป	The village was wiped out by the flood.
