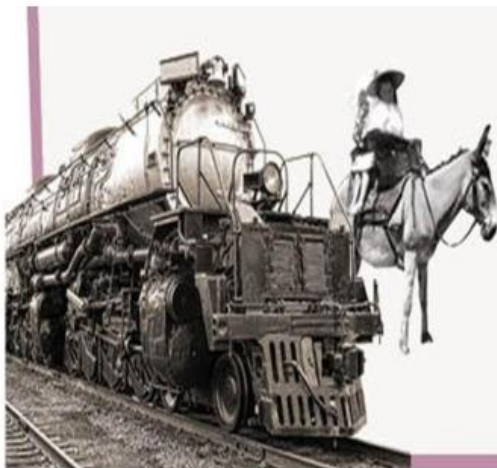

SEASIDE HOLIDAYS in the past

Today, when people want to go on a seaside holiday, they take a train, plane, ship or drive to a seaside resort. They spend all day swimming, sunbathing and doing water sports. But it wasn't like that in the past.

Before the railway, people didn't travel much. But in the 1840s there were trains all over Britain, so a day trip or even a week at the seaside became easy.

Of course, seaside holidays were very different from today. People wore all their clothes on the beach because they didn't want a suntan. When women wanted to go into the water, they wore bathing costumes. These costumes looked like dresses.



On the beach people used bathing machines. They used them as a place to change their clothes. When they were ready, a horse pulled the bathing machine near the sea and they entered the water.

In the past, there wasn't much to do on the beach. Not many people knew how to swim, so they just walked in the water. Walks on the beach were popular, too, and some beaches even had donkey rides.
