POSITIVE	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	VERB	He often cooks pasta.
	SUBJECT	BE	FREQUENCY ADVERB	You are always late.
QUESTION	AUXILIARY	SUBJECT	FREQUENCY ADVERB	Are you always late? Does he often cook?

⚠ Use NEVER and HARDLY EVER with positive verbs

✗ He isn't never late.

✗ They don't hardly ever go to the library.

✓ He is never late.

✓ They hardly ever go to the library.
