

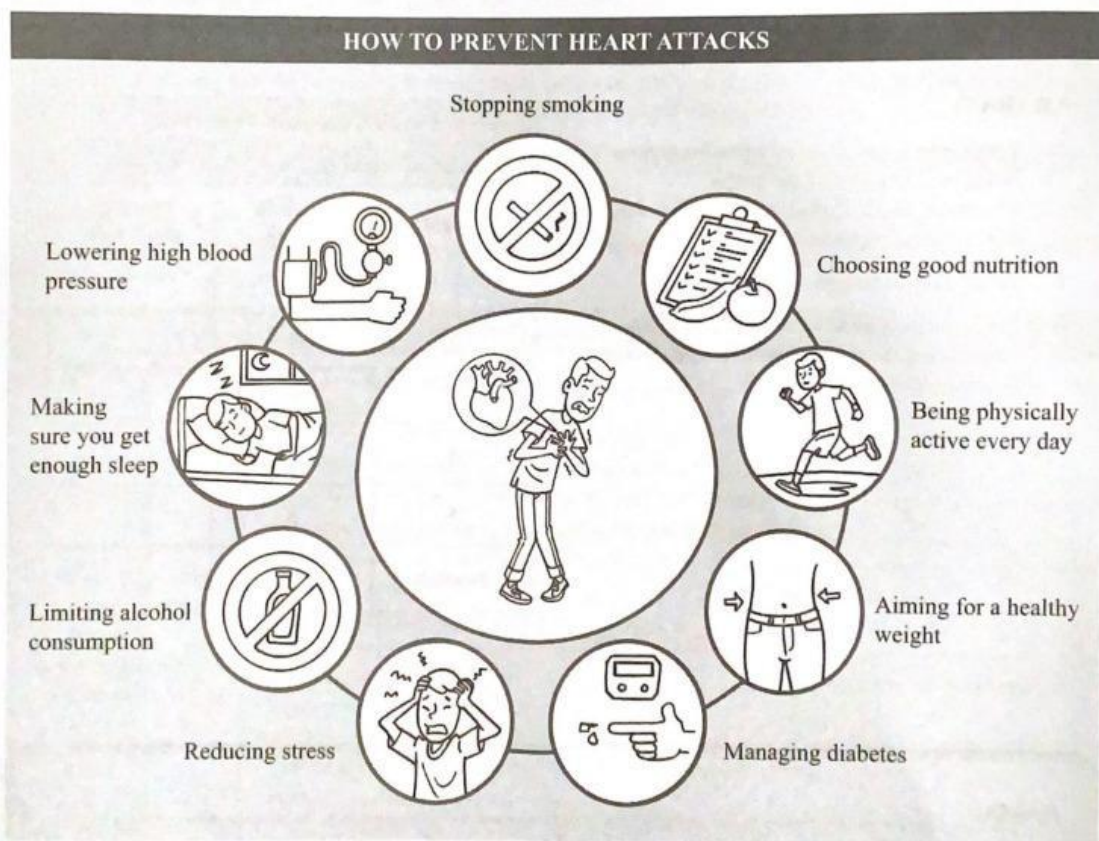

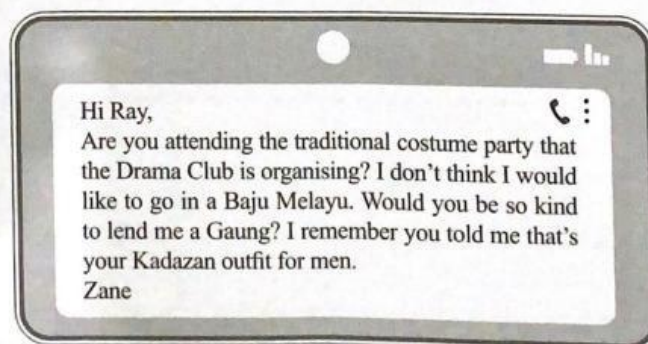

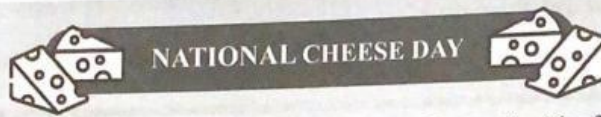

A Former National Badminton Player
