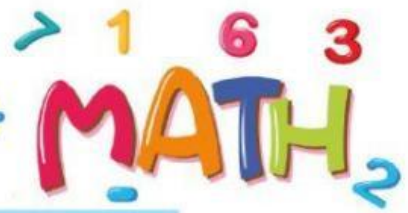


Operaciones combinadas



- Primero nos fijamos si tienen paréntesis o no.
- Si no tienen paréntesis resolvemos siempre de izquierda a derecha.
- Si tienen paréntesis, resolvemos primero lo del paréntesis y luego el resto en orden.



1. Resuelve las operaciones combinadas

a) $15 - 10 + 7$

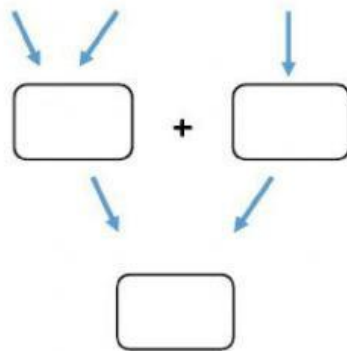
a) Jaime tenía 12 colores, se gastaron 10 y le compraron 20 colores nuevos. ¿Cuántos colores tiene ahora?
