When a person applies for a job, a manager (boss) talks to that person. The boss decides to hire that person (give the person the job) or not hire that person.

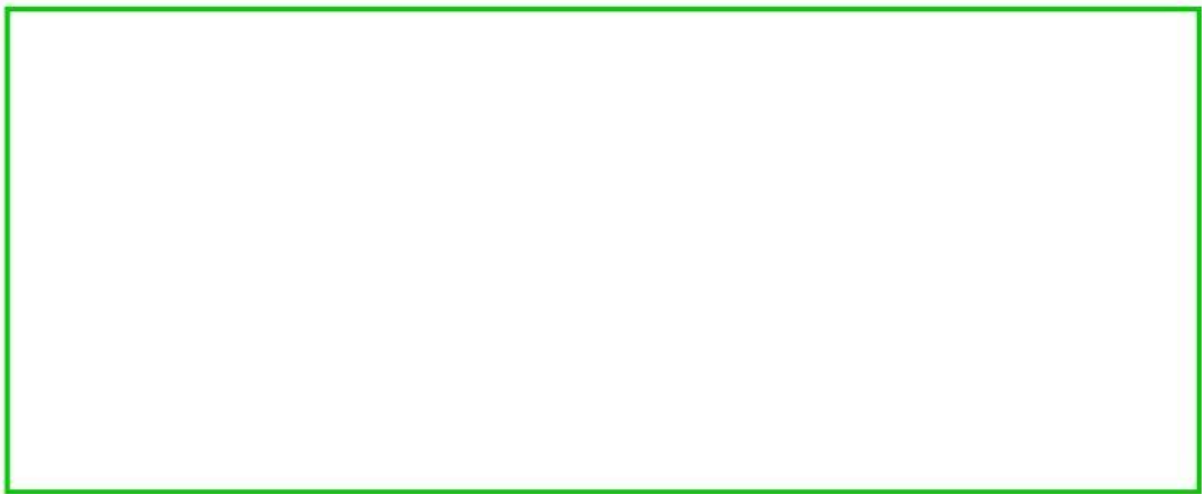
What does "hire" mean? _____

In a democracy, the citizens are the "boss" for many government jobs. A person or group of people (ex. Democrats, Republicans) **nominates** someone for a job. The citizens listen to the **nominees** from each group. The citizens decide which **nominee** to hire. They decide by voting.

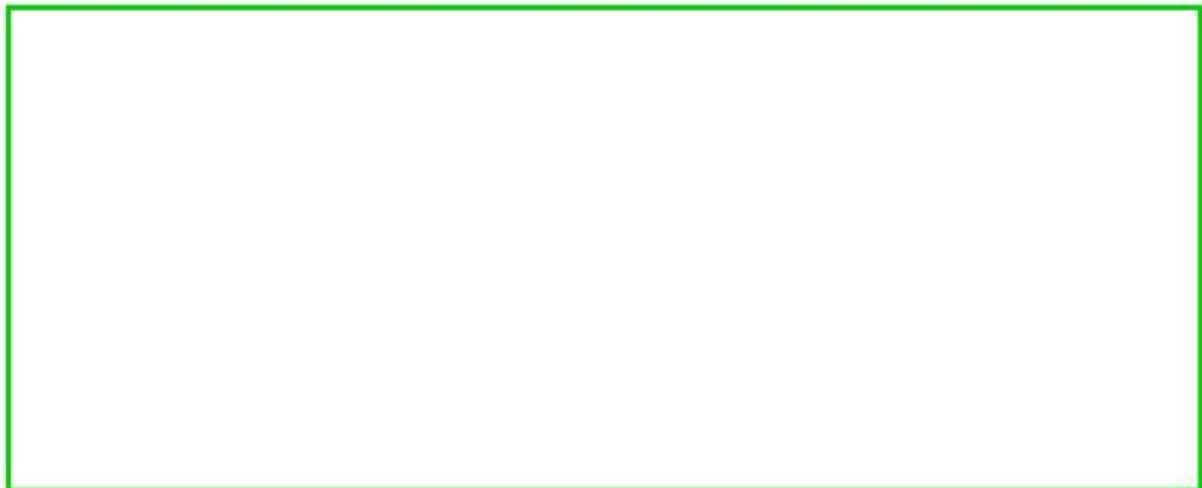
