

2 Nimara Cave, Marmaris, Turkey

Nimara Cave is located on Heaven Island, near Marmaris. Confusingly, Heaven Island isn't really an island: it's connected to the mainland by a thin strip of land, which we'll walk across to reach the cave. According to recent research, human presence in the cave dates back to almost 12 000 years ago. It's found at the highest point of Heaven Island and was used mainly as a place of worship by the ancient residents of the town of Nimara, now known as Marmaris. The cave is a protected area, and you're sure to see the rare species of butterfly that it's famous for, as well as many other interesting creatures. A bargain at just \$80!

3 Jungle Tour, Krabi, Thailand

This \$100 tour is limited to eight people, so you'll get to know the other visitors and your guide well during the day. Setting off from Krabi Town by minibus, visitors are taken first to the hot spring waterfall. After a walk in the rainforest along the jungle nature trail, your tour fee also includes a delicious Thai lunch at a local restaurant. The tour continues to Tiger Cave Temple to visit the meditation centre there, returning to Krabi well before it gets dark.
