Watch the video then place the events of the story in the correct order.

He decides to use them to raise a storm and trap his enemies on the island with him.

One of Shakespeare's most famous comedies is a play called *The Tempest*.

Here they lived alone, apart from the spirit Ariel and the beast Caliban, who were Prospero's servants.

Prospero has magic powers.

In the past Prospero, the rightful Duke of Milan, and his infant daughter Miranda were abandoned at sea because his wicked brother, Antonio, seized power.

The storm causes Antonio's ship to be destroyed.

Later, the other shipwreck victims, including evil Antonio, find Prospero.

Prospero and Miranda survived as they landed on a remote island.

He gives up his magic powers and makes plans to set sail for home to take up his rightful position as Duke.

One of those shipwrecked is Ferdinand, the Prince of Naples.

The shipwreck victims wash up in different places on the island.

Before he does so he frees Ariel and only the evil beast Caliban is left behind.

Ferdinand and Miranda fall in love as soon as they set eyes on each other.

They then become engaged.

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
