






Gunung Agung is one of Indonesia's leading bookstore companies. It is named after a volcanic mountain in Bali, Indonesia. The origin of the bookstore dates back to 1953 when the late Tjio Wie Tay (1927- 1990), who later became popularly known as Haji Masagung, started a kiosk selling books, newspaper and magazines in Central Jakarta. As the business grew bigger and more complex in the early post-independence years, Haji Masagung established a new company that published and imported books, named Firma Gunung Agung. The company continued to grow with the support of poets, writers, scholars and journalists. Amidst the difficulties faced by the new nation, Haji Masagung pioneered the effort to open the eyes of the nation through books. He organized Indonesia's first book fair in 1954.
