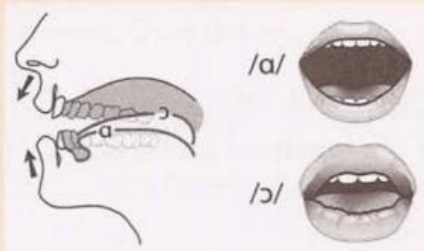

Using Stress and Intonation to Show a Contrast



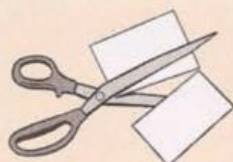
Practice the sound /a/.

and make them round.

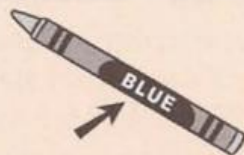
