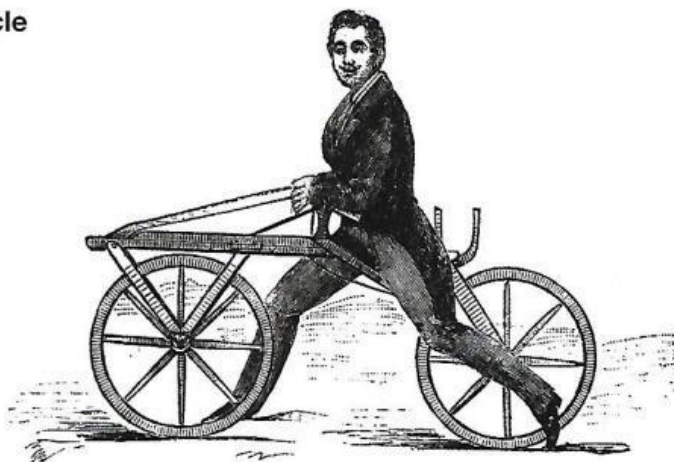

The bicycle
