

# PAST PERFECT 2

We form the past perfect with *had/hadn't + past participle*. It indicates a past action occurring prior to another past action. Read the sentences and fill in the blanks with the correct form of the past perfect.

Example: We **hadn't started** dinner before she arrived.

First action - not eating, second action - arriving.
