Past Simple (The Verb Be): Positive & Negative

- ★ We use the **past simple** to talk about something that happened in the past.
- ★ The verb *be* has two past forms: **was** and **were**.
- ★ We often use the past simple with these words: *yesterday, last week, last year, etc.*

Positive		
I	was	a teacher last year.
He/She/It	was	in London last week.
We/You/They	were	sick yesterday.
Negative		
I	was not (=wasn't)	a teacher last year.
He/She/It	was not (=wasn't)	in London last week.
We/You/They	were not (=weren't)	sick yesterday.



There **was** a big storm last night.
I **was** very scared.



Bob **wasn't** the captain of our team.
Dave **was** the captain.
