Lots of notes sung to one syllable.	
Texture where you hear a melody with accompaniment, or, where all the parts play a similar rhythm in harmony.	
Getting gradually faster.	
A repeating melodic or rhythmic pattern.	
A musical form in 3 parts - ABA	
A melody which is sung above the main melody.	
Broken chord accompaniment in the bass	
A note held, or repeated, in an upper part.	
A moving bass line with notes usually of the same value. It is often found in jazz styles	
A melody played against the main melody.	
Unaccompanied singing	
A musical form in 2 parts - AB	
A long held or repeated note in the bass.	
Getting gradually quieter	
Each part has the same melody entering one after the other.	
Accented notes are played off or against the beat	
Getting gradually slower	
A texture which consists of two or more independent melodic lines interweaving.	
An upbeat at the start of a phrase.	
A theme in the bass which is repeated many times while the upper parts are varied	
Two players or singers sounding the same notes or notes an octave apart at the same time
