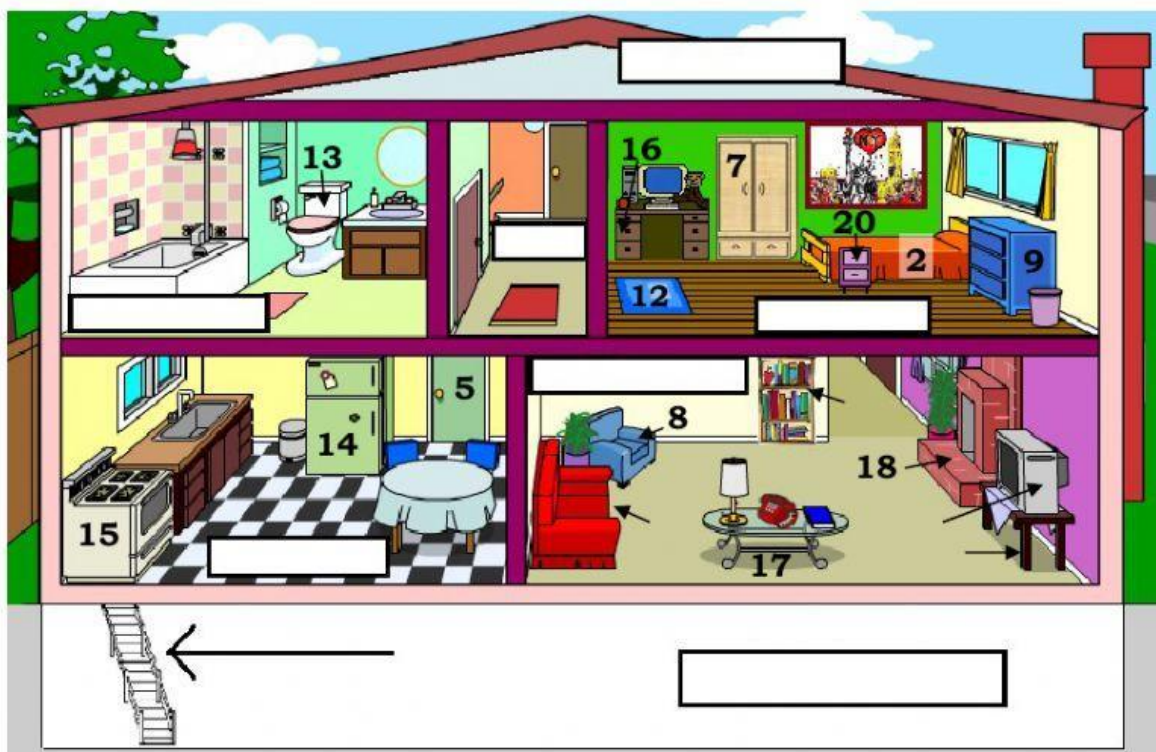

Ellen: Sounds great! Is there a garage? And a guest room ?

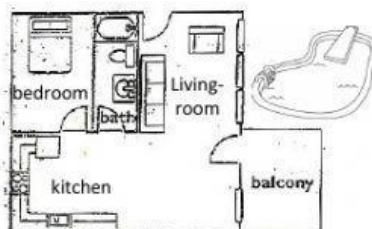
Peter: No, there isn't a guest room. Our guests can sleep in the living-room on the convertible sofa. But there is a garage and there's a pool, too. And a balcony!

- **Pool** = swimming-pool

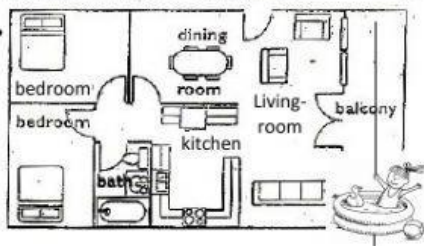
