Girls are computer geeks too

When we think of computer programmers, we usually think of nerdy boys and men, with glasses, in a room by themselves, making magic. We usually think of the Bill Gates and the Mark Zuckerbergs and the Steve Jobs of Silicon Valley. In other words, we do not usually associate girls and women with computers and coding. The organisation *Girls who Code* is working to change this idea and this reality. The organisation started in 2012 in New York. *Girls who Code* has free clubs and summer courses all

across the United States to teach girls about programming and coding. The organisation wants to create a group of future female computer engineers.

The number of female computer engineers has gone down from 37% in 1995 to 24% in 2017. *Girls who Code* is working to change this.
