Town Mouse sits in his big house in the town. 'I love my home,' he says.

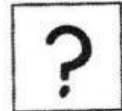
2. Összefoglaló a QUIZ készítéséhez

You are hungry.

Betty is under the bed.

2.) A) Most a **do / does** segédige segítségével csináljunk kérdéseket a többi igével az egyszerű jelen időben, hiszen a mese is ebben az igeidőben íródott.

Például:

-Ha van kérdőszó (What, Why, When, Where, How, Who) a kérdésben, akkor a válasz kifejtős.

-A kérdőszavak mindig a kérdőmondat legelején vannak.

-A **What.....like?** = **Milyen?** esetén:

Pl. **What's the weather like?** - **Milyen az időjárás?** Itt a **What** a mondat elején, a **like** a mondat végén van mindig. A két szó között pedig az szerepel, amire kíváncsiak vagyunk, hogy milyen.

A példában az időjárás milyenségére voltunk kíváncsiak.
