## A Helping Hand

Homelessness is a common <sup>1</sup> **phenomenon / responsibility** in New York City. Perhaps that explains why hundreds of people ignored Leo Grand, a homeless man, as they passed by every morning on their way to work. Patrick McConlogue, a young software engineer, was one of them. Every morning for three years, Patrick <sup>2</sup> **risked the life of / observed** the homeless man on the sidewalk as he walked by.
