- "What is an elephant?" a blind man asked.

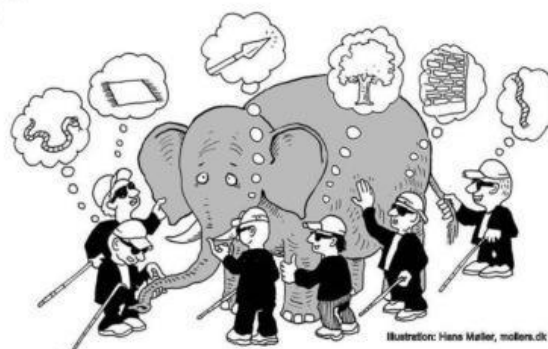
- "I don't know," said another. "Let's find out!"
