 - At least two sentences using "have/has" to describe items in your house.
 - A variety of sentence structures to make your description clear and detailed.
3. Organize your text into 3 paragraphs:
 - Introduction: Who lives in your house and how many floors/rooms it has.
 - Description of key rooms and spaces: Describe the main areas of your house (living room, kitchen, bedrooms, etc.).
 - Personal opinion or favorite place: Share your favorite part of your house and explain why.
4. Use complete sentences and check your spelling and grammar before submitting your text.
