There is more to the history of electricity than most people know. For example, many people think Benjamin Franklin or Thomas Edison were the only people to develop ways of generating electricity, but they weren't. As with most technologies, whole teams of people were involved in its development. Other important electrical scientists include Guericke, Tesla, Curie, Lodygin, and Yablochkov.

Electricity first came to people's homes in the 1870s, but it wasn't common until the 1930s. Its first use was to light homes and workplaces. In many ways, life got more comfortable with electricity. Ice boxes were replaced by refrigerators, and water could be heated for cooking or washing.

These days, we use electricity for everything: light, heat, sound, communication, and travel. There are cars that can be driven 500 or 600 km on one battery charge, and electric planes are being developed for international travel. In the future, all electricity will be from natural sources such as the sun, water, or wind. Hopefully, this will help us to protect the environment and our planet.
