She works at the (13) _____ in town and she looks after the (14) _____ there. She's very kind to them, but she has to wear a (15) _____ and I wouldn't want to do that.

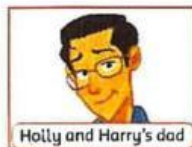
