





Winston Churchill was prime minister of the United Kingdom on two separate occasions. He was born in 1874. He was a member of the army and went to many different countries. He married his wife Clementine Hozier in 1908. He became the prime minister in 1940. During World War II, the UK won many historic battles to help end the war. He was famous during that time for speaking to the people of the UK in speeches and on the radio. Many people believe he gave people hope during difficult times. He died in 1965 after many health problems. Many people who look at famous world leaders agree Churchill is one of the greatest leaders in the history of that country.
