

PAST CONTINUOUS FOR INTERRUPTED ACTIONS FOR DAILY MORNING ROUTINES:

We use the past continuous tense with the simple past tense when a long action is interrupted by a short action. The actions are connected by the word 'when'.

FORM: Subject + was/were + verb-ing (past continuous tense) + (object) + when + subject + verb (past simple tense)
