Prepositions of time (*in, on, at*)


Where does he work?

Where **does he** work?



He works in a police station.

Where **does she** work?



She works in a hospital.



Where does he work? is a wh- question. We use **where** to ask about a place. We use **does** to make questions with **he, she** and **it** in the present simple. The word order changes in questions.

Statement

He works ...

She works ...

It works ...

Where **does** he work?

Where **does** she work?

Where **does** it work?




Does he work ...? Yes, he does. No, he doesn't.
