Billie Eilish Pirate Baird O'Connell was born on December 18, 2001, in Los Angeles, California. She is an American singer, songwriter, and music producer.

Billie was born into a creative family. Her parents, Patrick O'Connell and Maggie Baird, are both musicians and actors, and they encouraged Billie and her brother Finneas to be involved in music from a young age.

Billie became famous in 2015 when she uploaded her song "Ocean Eyes" to the platform SoundCloud. This song quickly went viral and caught the attention of music fans and record labels. In 2017, she released her first EP, titled "Don't Smile at Me".
