Rules	Examples
Most verbs take -s in the third person singular.	work – work s , dance – dance s , read – read s , speak – speak s
Verbs ending in -ss, -sh, -ch, -x and -o take -es .	kiss – kiss es , wash – wash es , watch – watch es , fix- fix es
Verbs ending in a consonant + y , drop the y and take -ies .	study – stud ies , cry – c ries fly – fl ies , copy – cop ies
Verbs ending in a vowel + y , take -s .	play – play s , say – say s , enjoy – enjoy s , obey - obe ys

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Don't - Doesn't

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ENGLISH

We use **Don't** or **Doesn't** to make a **negative sentence** in the **simple present tense**.*

* Exceptions: Negative sentences that use **To Be** or **Modal Verbs** (can, might, etc.)

Subject	+	Auxiliary	+	Verb **
I / you / we / they	+	don't	+	go ...
he / she / it	+	doesn't	+	want ...
				like ...

Affirmative: You speak English.

Negative: You **don't** speak English.

Affirmative: He speaks English.

Negative: He **doesn't** speak English.

**** The base form of the infinitive = to go, to need, to speak, to live**

Third person verbs lose the final "s" in negative sentences.

Be careful...

I ~~no~~ live in Japan. ❌

I **don't** live in Japan. ✅

Affirmative: She has a cat. ✅

Negative: She **doesn't** ~~has~~ a cat. ❌

Negative: She **doesn't** ~~have~~ a cat. ✅

Contractions

don't = do not

doesn't = does not
