Clara gasped. It was her scarf! How did he...?

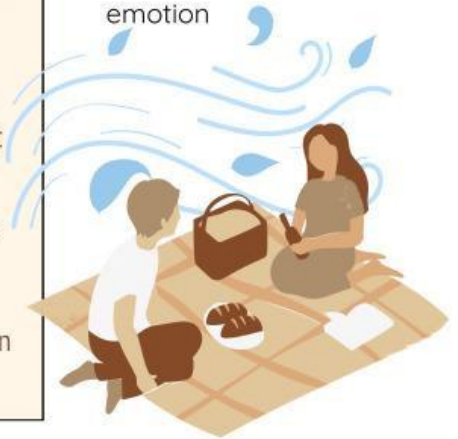
"I saw it falling to the ground," Alex explained, "and I knew how much it meant to you."
