<p data-bbox="327 309 596 338" style="text-align: center;"><b>The Sumatran Tiger</b></p>  <p data-bbox="161 685 762 869"><sup>(1)</sup>The Sumatran Tiger (<i>Panthera tigris sumatrae</i>) is a unique tiger species found only on the island of Sumatra, Indonesia. <sup>(2)</sup>The Sumatran tiger is the smallest of all tiger subspecies.</p> <p data-bbox="161 913 762 987"><sup>(3)</sup>The size of males growing up to 2.4 meters long and weighing around 100 to 140 kilograms.</p> <p data-bbox="161 994 762 1111"><sup>(4)</sup>Females are smaller, weighing 75 to 110 kilograms. <sup>(5)</sup>Its fur is orange with black stripes, which help it blend into the forest.</p> <p data-bbox="161 1137 762 1509"><sup>(6)</sup>This tiger lives in tropical rainforests, mangrove swamps, and grasslands. <sup>(7)</sup>It is a carnivore, eating animals like deer, wild pigs, and small mammals. <sup>(8)</sup>The Sumatran Tiger is known for being a solitary animal, with males and females coming together only during mating season. <sup>(9)</sup>Tigers are territorial and often mark their area with scent markings to warn other tigers. <sup>(10)</sup>They are strong swimmers and can cross rivers in search of food or territory.</p> <p data-bbox="161 1516 762 1700"><sup>(11)</sup>The Sumatran Tiger is now critically endangered because of habitat loss, deforestation, and illegal hunting. <sup>(12)</sup>Protecting forests and stopping hunting are very important to save this animal.</p>	<p data-bbox="948 309 1262 338" style="text-align: center;"><b>The Sumatran Elephant</b></p>  <p data-bbox="788 663 1422 736"><sup>(1)</sup>The Sumatran Elephant (<i>Elephas maximus sumatranus</i>) is a subspecies of the Asian elephant.</p> <p data-bbox="788 743 1422 882"><sup>(2)</sup>It is smaller than other subspecies Asian elephants such as Indian Elephant (<i>Elephas maximus indicus</i>) and Sri Lankan Elephant (<i>Elephas maximus maximus</i>).</p> <p data-bbox="788 927 1422 1001"><sup>(3)</sup>The height of Sumatran elephant about 2 to 3 meters and a weight of 2,000 to 4,000 kilograms.</p> <p data-bbox="788 1008 1422 1081"><sup>(4)</sup>It has gray skin and large ears, which help it stay cool in hot weather.</p> <p data-bbox="788 1126 1422 1715"><sup>(5)</sup>This elephant lives in the tropical forests of Sumatra, Indonesia. <sup>(6)</sup>It eats grass, fruits, leaves, and bark. <sup>(7)</sup>The Sumatran Elephant is social and lives in groups, usually led by a female, known as the matriarch. <sup>(8)</sup>These groups help protect the younger elephants from predators. <sup>(9)</sup>They communicate with each other using low-frequency sounds that can travel long distances through the forest. <sup>(10)</sup>Sumatran Elephants are also known for their intelligence and memory, which helps them find food and navigate their environment. <sup>(11)</sup>They are endangered because of deforestation and illegal hunting. <sup>(12)</sup>Many forests are cut down for farming, leaving the elephants without a home. <sup>(13)</sup>Protecting forests is very important to keep this species alive.</p>

Mentawai scops owl and has a relatively small body size, measuring about 25 cm in length. It has distinctive brownish-gray feathers with patterns that help it camouflage in the dense tropical forests. Its large eyes and deep-set sockets provide excellent night vision, as it is nocturnal, meaning it is active at night to hunt for prey. Its main diet consists of insects and other small animals.
