The Beatles were an English rock band, formed in Liverpool in 1960. They are composed of four members: John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr. They were one of the most influential and successful bands in the history of music, revolutionizing the musical world with their innovations and the enormous cultural impact they had.

The band was formed when John Lennon invited Paul McCartney to join his group, The Quarrymen, in 1957. George Harrison joined soon after, followed by Ringo Starr in 1962. They achieved great success with their first single, "Love Me Do", released in 1962, which marked the beginning of their phenomenal career.

They experimented with various musical genres and recording techniques, which profoundly influenced contemporary music. Their music and style had a great cultural impact, influencing fashion, art and politics of the time.

The band officially broke up in 1970, following various internal tensions and creative differences. All members went on to pursue solo musical careers, with varying success. John Lennon and Paul McCartney in particular enjoyed great success as solo artists.
