The Solar System is a group of planets, moons, and other objects that orbit the Sun. The Sun is at the center of the Solar System and is a very hot, glowing ball of gas. It provides light and heat to all the planets.

There are eight planets in the Solar System. The four planets closest to the Sun are **Mercury, Venus, Earth, and Mars**. These are called the "rocky planets" because they are made mostly of rock.

The next four planets are **Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, and Neptune**. These are called the "gas giants" because they are very large and made mostly of gas. Jupiter is the largest planet in the Solar System, and Saturn is famous for its beautiful rings.

The Solar System also has dwarf planets, like Pluto, and smaller objects, like asteroids and comets. These objects orbit the Sun, too.

Our planet, Earth, is the third planet from the Sun. It is special because it has air, water, and the perfect temperature for life.
