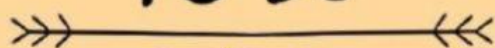

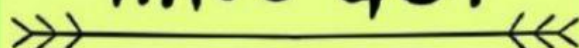
Ser/Estar

I/You/We/They HAVE GOT
+ He/She/It HAS GOT

I/You/We/They HAVEN'T GOT
- (have not got)
He/She/It HASN'T GOT
(has not got)

HAS He/She/It GOT?
