inch (n) /ɪntʃ/	a unit of length measurement that is equal to 2.54 centimeters	The screen of my new laptop is 14 inches .
screen (n) /skri:n/	a flat display used for showing words or images in a theater, on television, or as part of a computer	It is exciting to watch movies on a big screen .
storage (n) /'stɔ:ɹɪdʒ/	the area on a computer, phone or tablet used to store data, music, etc.	My new smartphone has a lot of storage , so I can store a lot of photos.
weight (n) /weɪt/	the amount that an object or a person weighs	Modern computers are often light in weight these days.
gigabyte (n) /'gɪɡəbaɪt/	a unit of digital information	The new laptop model has 256 gigabytes of storage .

Wh- questions and Yes/No questions

- We can use Wh- questions to ask for details about things, people, events, etc.

Wh-questions	Answers
What is the screen size?	The screen is 11 inches.
How heavy are these laptops?	It weighs about 1.2 kg.
How many cameras does this phone have?	It includes three cameras.
How much storage does your computer have?	It has a storage capacity of 128 gigabytes.
Where is the power button-of this tablet?	It is on the right side.
Who bought this new machine?	A graphics designer bought it.

- We use Yes/No questions to ask about specific things. Yes or No is the answer.

Yes/No questions	Answers
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Does your phone have much storage?	Yes, it does. / No, it doesn't.
Is the battery life long?	Yes, it is. / No, it isn't.
