A. GRAMMAR

❖ Past continuous (Quá khứ tiếp diễn)

- **Cách dùng:** Chúng ta sử dụng Thì quá khứ tiếp diễn để diễn tả một hành động đã đang xảy ra trong quá khứ thì có hành động khác xen vào (Dùng Thì quá khứ đơn để diễn tả hành động xen vào).
- **Cấu trúc:**

Khẳng định	Phủ định	Nghi vấn
S + was / were + V-ing.	S + was / were + not + V-ing.	Was / Were + S + V-ing? ➔ Yes, S + was / were. ➔ No, S + was / were + not.

- Ví dụ:

1. When I **was singing** in the bathroom, my mother **came** in.
(Hành động đang xảy ra) (Hành động xen vào)
2. The light **went** out when we **were watching** TV.
(Hành động xen vào) (Hành động đang xảy ra)

❖ Prepositions of direction (Giới từ chỉ phương hướng)

- **Cách dùng:** Giới từ chỉ phương hướng hay còn gọi là giới từ chỉ sự chuyển động, dùng để chỉ sự di chuyển từ nơi này sang nơi khác. Những giới từ này mang ý nghĩa mô tả chuyển động và chúng ta thường sử dụng chúng với động từ chuyển động.
- **Ví dụ:**

Preposition	Meaning	Example
to	Chỉ 1 điểm đến hoặc 1 hướng	The boys go to school in group.
toward(s)	Chỉ theo hướng của ai hoặc cái gì đó	From there, you walk towards the traffic lights.
through	Mô tả chuyển động xuyên qua một khu vực, một cái gì đó như: thâm cỏ, rừng rậm,...	David walked slowly through the woods.
into	Chỉ 1 chuyển động đi vào một không gian, thường là với một động từ thể hiện chuyển động	Do not put new wine into old bottles.
over	Chuyển động ở mức độ cao hơn bất kỳ thứ gì khác	He jumped over the wall.
across	Chỉ chuyển động từ 1 phía của cái gì đó sang phía đối diện (con đường, dòng sông)	He walked across the street.
up	Chỉ chuyển động hướng lên trên hoặc ở hướng dọc theo con đường	We live just up the road, past the church.

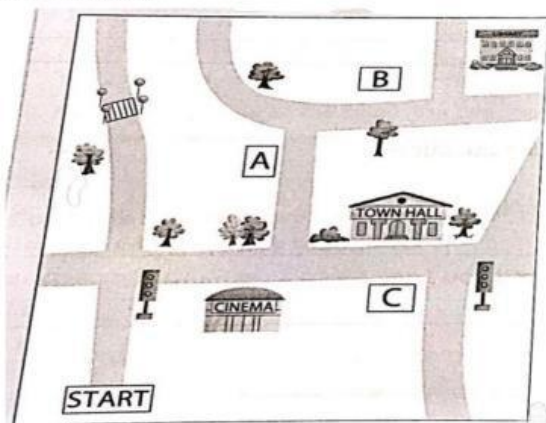
