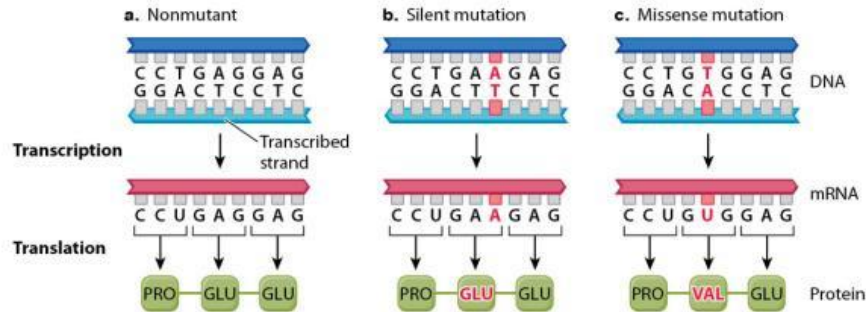




LG 37.1 Mutations can affect one or a few bases or entire chromosomes.

- If a point mutation arises in a protein-coding gene, it can result in no change in the amino acid sequence (silent mutation) or a change in the amino acid sequence (missense mutation).
